It's functional, understated and organic and perfect for smaller spaces. Hand crafted textures and materials, and a ligh decorative touch, make it a calming and affordable delight.



Style Checklist

BATHROOMS

Go for tiles with light, cool grey and earthy tones and colour match the grout to the tile

For cabinetry use light timbers (or timberlook veneers) such as pine and oak Design with light in mind so position mirrors to reflect existing light Small elements of metal such as gold or copper tapware are Scandi-perfect Style with towels in ether white or cool grey tones with minimal pattern

MAIN FLOOR TILE

Try wood look plank tiles in light hues – they emulate timber and are perfect for wet areas

Then use the same colour grout as your tile to avoid patterning

KITCHENS

Choose white, light greys and timbers for cabinetry

Use open shelving but don't have too much clutter on show (a couple of recipe books, drinking glasses and plates is fine)
Benchtops using marble or concrete are a great natural choice




Time to layer with woollen rugs, faux fur and neutral velvet finishes in similar colours

If you want some extra colour, opt for light pastel shades such as blue and/or blush Keep ornaments to a minimum Select functional furnishings in natural woods

BATHROOMS

Choose a tuxedo-style palette. Its black and white hues are elegant and timeless Or create a feature wall in textured tiles and frame it with understated floor tiles Create a balanced space incorporating clean sharp lines with soft elements, like floor-to-ceiling sheer curtains, and indoor plants

Glam it up with gold taps or a feature claw foot bath in dramatic black and white

MAIN FLOOR TILE

You can use either light or dark tiles here so nail your interior colour scheme first

KITCHENS

Embrace white or light marble and accent with a natural hue

Choose timber look tiles (perfect for wet areas)

You can also mix tile patterns to add texture

Try a Herringbone tile floor with English Cross Bond tiles as a feature wall or splashback


Don't go overly ornate; use contemporary furniture with subtle classic details Go for tactile fabrics and upholstery and layer with handpicked textiles like linen, velvet or other softer fabrics



Choose modern tapware in brushed nickel, pearl chrome, brass or matt black

Select simple, smoother finishes like polished concrete, large tiles or wood look replicate tiles




Keep lines clean with sharp corners, concealed hinges and squared handles

Keep countertops clear and highlight with impressive chrome taps



BATHROOMS

Use traditional rounded tapware and decorative handles in chrome, gold, rose gold or brass or white

If budget allows, pick a feature claw-foot bath

Shaker style cabinetry is perfect Barn-style wall lights give a simple but charming ambience

MAIN FLOOR TILE

Stick to earthy tones such as natural timber-look tiles or stone looks
For drama, choose a darker tile with some light and dark rustic highlights
Run the indoor tile to the outdoors

KITCHENS

It's the centre piece of a country home so choose a big deep ceramic basin Benchtops should be white or cool grey, or opt for traditional timber Top with overhead open shelved cabinetry and display dinner sets and plasses







Super tips for Sparkling walls and floors

Tiles are a perfect choice for floors and walls.

They're affordable, low maintenance and durable, and great for people with health conditions, like asthma. Under tile heating makes them suitable no matter where you live.

Contemporary decor puts tiles at the centre of design and not just for traditional areas such as bathrooms and kitchens.

Tiles are now part of an entire home design; they're being used on walls to create art gallery inspired features, and across living areas into the outdoors to create a wonderful feel of space.

It's easy to keep tiles looking great, just follow these tips.

GENERAL CLEANING

- Sweep, or better still, vacuum tiles regularly so dirt doesn't build up
- Clean tiles with mild detergent or household cleaner (no acid or alkaline), or go natural by mixing vinegar and warm water

- Avoid abrasive cleaners (powders and gritty cream) as they can scratch and make tiles harder to clean
- Remove a stubborn spot by gently scrubbing with a paste of bicarbonate of soda and water

PREVENT DAMAGE

Avoid scratches by using gliders under furniture and good mats at the front door to keep out grit. Ditch the high heels if your floors are high gloss.

Just one more. Always buy an extra box of tiles in case you need some spares in the future.
